Business Meeting: Tuesday October 11, 2016 6:00 at Brushy Mountain Smokehouse and Creamery - next meeting November 1, 2016.

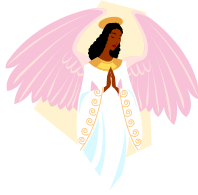
Our November meeting will be the first Tues. Nov. 1st. This change is to give everyone an opportunity to Vote on Nov. 8th.
