

The Perfect Man

Chocolate Hersey Bar Cake

1 BOX DUNCAN HINES CHOCOLATE CAKE MIX 1 SMALL BOX INSTANT VANILLA PUDDING MIX 1 1/2 CUPS MILK 1 CUP CORN OIL

MIX ALL TOGETHER WELL.
THIS BATTER WILL MAKE 3-- 8 INCH PANS
2-- 9 INCH PANS OR 1-- 9 1/2 X 11 INCH PAN
BAKE AT 325 DEGREES UNTIL FIRM

I SPLIT MY LAYERS BEFORE ICING.

FOR THE 9 1/2 X 11 PAN, I MAKE TWO OF THIS SIZE AND STACK THEM. I DO NOT SPLIT THESE LAYERS.

ICING

1 8 0Z. SOFTENED CHEESE 1 CUP POWDERED SUGAR 1/2 CUP REGULAR SUGAR

BLEND TOGETHER UNTIL YOU CANNOT FEEL THE SUGAR GRAINS.

ADD:

1 12oz. COOL WHIP.

BLEND WELL WITH MIXER.

STIR INTO ICING: 1/2 CUP GRATED HERSEY CHOCOLATE BAR.
SPRINKLE GRATED HERSEY BAR ON TOP OF CAKE AFTER ICING.
I JUST USE A LITTLE ICING BETWEEN THE LAYERS IF YOU SPLIT THEM.

FOR THE 9 1/2 X 11 INCH CAKE, MAKE TWO RECIPES OF THE ICING. PUT MORE ICING BETWEEN THESE LAYERS.

HAS TO BE KEPT COOL AFTER ICING
